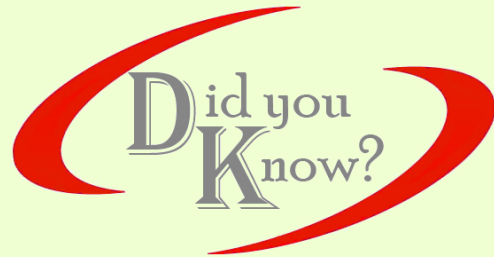
Collect taxes from the prior, prior year. So, you will need to use your parent's 2019 taxes. There is a feature on FAFSA that will allow you to pull tax information from the IRS.

**STEP 1-** Student needs to create a FSAid through <https://fsaid.ed.gov/npas/index.htm>

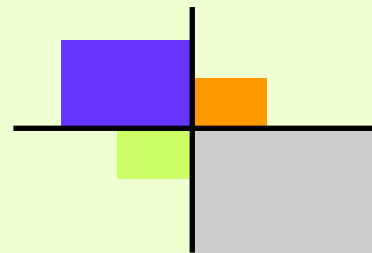
**STEP 2 -** If the parent does not have an FSAid, they will need to create one through <https://fsaid.ed.gov/npas/index.htm>.

If you already have one and cannot remember it, you can go to Manage my FSAid.

**STEP 3-** Go to <http://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa> and make sure you are filling out the FAFSA under the student's name and for the 2021 school year. (You should never have to pay for FAFSA).



You can go to any local school (College of the Albemarle in Elizabeth City and Elizabeth City State University) for Financial Aid help. You **DO NOT** have to be applying to those schools to receive help. Of course, you can reach out to your high school counselors if you have any questions too.
