

PARENTS: WHAT TO EXPECT IF YOUR STUDENT IS REQUIRED TO QUARANTINE OR TESTS POSITIVE

COVID-19



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SCHOOL NURSE

In situations in which your student receives a positive COVID-19 diagnosis or has been identified as a close contact, parents should immediately contact the school nurse.

In situations in which your student is identified as a close contact at school, the school nurse will call a parent to make the notification. The school nurse will detail the length of time required for quarantine and when the student may return to school.



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QUARANTINE INFORMATION

Attendance- Students required to quarantine under the direction of a school nurse or other medical professional will be marked with a 1R- Present Off-Site code as long as students either 1) complete their daily assignments, and/or 2) have two way communication with their teacher.

The CDC continues to recommend quarantine for 14 days after last exposure. However, as of December 2, 2020, the CDC has offered options to reduce the duration of quarantine in either of the following 2 scenarios:

- * 10 days of quarantine have been completed and no symptoms have been reported during daily at home monitoring;
- * 7 days of quarantine have been completed, no symptoms have been reported during daily at home monitoring, and the individual has received results of a negative antigen or PCR/molecular test on a test taken no earlier than 5 days of quarantine.
- * If quarantine is discontinued before day 14, the individual should continue to monitor symptoms and strictly adhere to all non-pharmaceutical interventions (i.e. wear a mask, practice physical distancing) through 14 days after the date of last exposure.
- * Schools should follow the recommendations of their local public health department regarding quarantine. Local public health authorities make the final decisions about how long.



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SCHOOL WORK

A staff member from your student's school (Administrator/Counselor/Teacher) will reach out to discuss arrangements for your student to have access to instructional materials during quarantine.

Access to instructional materials may include assignments being posted to Google Classroom on the Chromebook or paper packets of assigned work to be picked up at the school.

Teachers will communicate with the parent and student about times that he/she will be available for assistance or to ask questions about the assigned work.

Please Note: Any student needing meals while on quarantine, should contact the school administration for assistance.
