- Taking credit, consciously or unconsciously, for work that is not your own or attempting to do so (i.e. Plagiarism).

- Talking to another student during any assessment (i.e. test, quiz) situation.
- Relaying or accepting information regarding an assessment.
- Making illegal corrections to an assessment/assignment prior to turning it in.
- Using unauthorized supplemental materials (i.e. tools, notes) in an assessment situation.
- Taking and/or using an assessment out of the classroom without permission.
- Failing to report students you have witnessed cheating.
- Attempting to evade late penalties.
